Although mentorships are reserved for women, MAWA also offers lectures, artist talks, studio visits, workshops, critical writing opportunities, screenings and symposia to people of all genders. Through skills and knowledge sharing, MAWA has created a vibrant community, serving artists in all phases of their careers.
