We aim to bring visibility and critical reception to artists and cultural practitioners when they need it most, often at moments early in their practices, and have offered important exhibition opportunities to many of Canada's most recognized contemporary artists.

As a not-for-profit artist-run centre, Access Gallery is a platform for emergent and experimental art practices. We foster critical dialogue and connection through diverse configurations of audience, artists, and community.
