Artist-organized solo and group exhibitions are emphasized, however exhibition and event proposals are also welcome from curators, collectives, designers, critics, scholars and students, as well as from community, literary, musical and cultural groups.

Programming emphasizes the work of local emerging artists, but occasionally features national and international exhibitions. The gallery welcomes contemporary visual art in all media, including drawing, painting, photography, sculpture, installation, performance, participatory art forms, video and new media.
