In partnership with art3 (Valence, France), OPTICA's residency program encourages the development of emerging practices. All these activities support critical reflection on current issues in art and stimulate the creation of new works, sustained and accompanied by the production of relevant publications. OPTICA's new location in Montreal's Mile End neighbourhood includes a documentation centre and a space for dialogue and exchange, the Agora, which serves as a forum for encounters with the public, promoting exchange and dialogue on its exhibition, residencies and community projects.
