Our production centre includes location gear and in-house recording and editing facilities for video and sound, as well as an open lab for electronic experimentation. Video Pool's unique 5.1 mixing suite offers state-of-the-art equipment housed in a specially designed acoustic space.

Our distribution department works to create income for artists while building and preserving a comprehensive catalogue of Canadian prairie video and sound art.

Video Pool also provides low-cost workshops for new and established artists, along with production funds to aid in the creation of new work—all this while offering free public exhibitions, artist talks and conferences to encourage awareness of and dialogue concerning new media art forms.
